Hi Katherine, Thank you for asking!

"I didn't even imagine that someone would commit such a fraud" is a primary defense tactic, yet it's smaller than a lot of the frauds we've experienced.

As a general observation, in the public sphere, it appears to me that there are at least as many disinformation agents as genuine targeted people, and they all tend to cite each other (I don't know anything about Miles Johnston, this is just a general observation). Also, I believe a lot of us who are being targeted in this manner (including you) are being targeted largely because of genealogy (bloodlines), which apparently is more than a passing interest to some people.

This is what Duncan says about himself on drrobertduncan.com: "Dr. Robert Duncan holds multiple degrees from Harvard University and Dartmouth College amongst others. He has had the most expensive American education money can buy." He also says "I am the all American - prep school, Harvard College graduating with honors in computer science and a minor in premedical studies, and advanced degrees from Harvard and Dartmouth in business and science. My famous ancestors are President Lincoln, King Duncan of Scotland, and Governor William Bradford, the first governor of Massachusetts." On projectsoulcatcher.com he lists himself as "Robert P. Duncan A.B., S.M., M.B.A., Ph.D."

So, while he claims a PhD (without any support) on projectsoulcatcher.com nowhere on <https://www.drrobertduncan.com> does Duncan claim to hold any kind of specific degree, but "advanced degrees" (multiple "advanced degrees") from Harvard and Dartmouth. Do you know any academic who talks about their history in this way? I don't. How freaking hard is it to say "I received my (insert specific degree here) from (insert specific school here) in (insert date here)." Or, you know, post a curriculum vitae.

And of course Duncan's demeanor is extremely unprofessional. He routinely resorts to personal insults when he's being challenged on factual matters. He also has poor spelling and grammar. What kind of idiots does Harvard graduate?

According to the the second link, the photographed degree certificate posted by Duncan was a Master's Degree, seemingly from Harvard, though the writer argues that it appears to be forged (forged or not, a Master's Degree is not a PhD, obviously).

When I initially did this research, my understanding was that Duncan claimed to hold a doctorate from Harvard. I can no longer find this specific claim, nor can I find anywhere where he says he received a doctorate from any specific school. Just that, when asked to provide a degree, he

provided what appeared to be Harvard (Masters) degree (possibly forged). According to this page, to find out for certain whether a person has a degree from Harvard, you have to at least know the school he or she graduated from: <https://www.harvard.edu/about-harvard/frequently-asked-questions/faq-verify-degree> - and then you write to the registrar.

One thing Duncan *has* done is made repeated references to a dissertation he wrote, including the title, "Computer Generated Holograms." This can be searched here: <https://hollis.harvard.edu/> and here result it returns: <http://id.lib.harvard.edu/alma/990092329780203941/catalog>

So Duncan published a Harvard thesis in 1991 - an UNDERGRADUATE thesis. It appears to me that he likely has a B.S. from Harvard (in more ways than one). This doesn't make him a doctor, obviously.

I don't see any other way to get any other solid information about his claims of having "advanced degrees." From my perspective, if the guy had a doctorate (or even a Masters' Degree) he would be referring to the research he did in graduate school, not an undergraduate thesis. Right?

It appears to me that "Dr." Duncan himself is a "computer generated hologram." (This crowd LOVES irony.)

Addendum: As I began researching this, about an hour ago, I looked briefly at Robert Duncan's facebook page, which was easy to find. Duncan claims that his hometown is Longview, Washington which is my partner Chris' hometown. Chris has, like me, has been targeted through his family line going back at least 7 generations. Longview is a small logging town in Washington State. Is Duncan really from Longview? I don't know, but that is weird. Anyway, as I was working on this, I thought, you know what, I'm just going to write to Duncan on Facebook and see if I can get him to make a specific claim about his PhD - and when I went back, 1/2 hour later and suddenly I CANNOT FIND HIS FACEBOOK PAGE. At all. As if it suddenly vanished. I searched on Google, searched on Facebook, tried all different search terms. Gone. Fortunately I still had my web history, so here's the link: <https://www.facebook.com/robert.duncan.94043626>

And here's the note I sent to hm:

Hi Mr Duncan, I'm hoping you can help me solve a debate. I often see you referred to as "Dr. Robert Duncan" and I was wondering if this means you have a doctorate degree - if so, can you let me know where the degree is from, what year you received it, and what the doctorate is in? Also, can you let me know if you have other advanced degrees (Masters Degrees or whatever you consider to be an advanced degree) where they are from, when you received them, and what they are in? Or point me to a CV with this information? Thank You.

Duncan's Facebook page shows a lot of activity, he made posts and comments yesterday, so he will definitely see my note. He either has the goods, or he doesn't. (Spoiler alert: he doesn't.)

I have also spent some time wondering how Duncan ended up at Harvard to begin with, especially if he's really from the little logging town of Longview, Washington. This appears to be a sort of pattern around the targeting that I experience. One of my ex-honeypots ended up at Harvard, and when I look back, I see in my journals that he was from a big family in northern Minnesota who were not super wealthy, yet ALL the kids somehow were receiving ivy league educations. A lot of my friends and neighbors ended up at places like Harvard, Berkeley, Brown.... more than makes sense, now that I know how hard it is to get into some of these schools, and how expensive they are. Right now, I honestly think that while these people were smart, they were probably not getting into these schools based on merit and wealth so much as based on working connections related to covert links to me. That's how I feel about it right now. And I suspect the same of Duncan, but with this added twist that is probably related to him being in Washington State, specific to the groups that target me and Chris from Washington State, who are linked with the entertainment industry. So what Duncan really is, is an entertainer and a time waster; he is not a scientist. However, because of the gravity of this situation, it is my opinion that he should not be treated as a joke but outed as a dangerous fraud.
